Assistance is available for:  
**Rental expenses**  
**Utility bills**  
**Security deposits**

If you are a Veteran\* who could benefit from this program you will need to bring the following documents to identify yourself and every member of your household:

- **Photo Id's**
- **Social Security Card**
- **Birth Certificates**
- **Income Verification\*\***

As the Veteran applying for services, you will also need to bring:

- **Form DD214**
- **Documentation of Need** (*proof of expenses including lease agreement, notice of late payments or eviction, utility bills, and other household bills*)

\*A Veteran is defined as a person who was discharged under conditions other than dishonorable.

\*\*Low-income eligibility must be verified.
